



INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A CLINICAL TRIAL

Are you over 18 years old and interested in participating in clinical trials? If 'yes' the Brien Holden Vision Institute is seeking volunteers who are experienced contact lens wearers for a clinical trial involving daily disposable contact lenses. The trial aims to compare the clinical performance and participant experience of a new daily disposable contact lens, in comparison to an equivalent lens available on the market. The clinical trial will run over 30 days, within which you will be required to attend a maximum of 3 scheduled visits. The clinical trial will randomly allocate the 2 daily disposable contact lenses. You will be required to wear the contact lenses for 30 days and complete At-home questionnaires regarding your experience of the contact lens being trialled.

STUDY DETAILS	
Trial start	March 2020
Lens wear details	You will be required to wear a daily disposable contact lenses for 30 days for a minimum 8 hours a day. The contact lenses that will be trialled are they ComCan Puriti Plus daily disposable contact lens and the Clariti 1 Day daily disposable contact lens. The contact lenses required for the 30-day trial, will be provided to you free of charge.
Visits	You will be required to attend a maximum of 3 scheduled visits. Visit 1: Baseline Assessment. Visit 2: Lens Fit. Visit 3: Exit Assessment. You will also be required to complete At-home questionnaire on day 1, 7, 15 and 29 of trial contact lens wear.
Recognition of participation	As recognition of your participation, you will receive a Westfield gift voucher per attended visit.
Additional information	You will be required to stop your personal contact lens wear for at least 2 days prior to commencing the clinical trial. If you are required to wear soft contact lenses to correct astigmatism, then you may not be suitable for this study. The ComCan Puriti Plus daily disposable contact lens is not approved for sale in Australia.
